Student Code of Conduct

Following are the conduct guidelines that should be exemplified in our students, as well as adults, involved in Ignite Student Ministry:

- **Clothing should not distract others from the message of the meetings, so nothing profane or immodest should be worn . Clothing with any suggestion of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs is strictly prohibited. Please note especially that young ladies (and guys too...) should not wear bikinis for water-related events.**
- **Worship service is a time set aside for worship, quiet meditation, and prayer. Please do not hinder others and yourself from the worship experience by passing notes and talking.**
- **Take pride in your church and facilities. Please clean up after yourself, especially when food and drink is involved. Respect the property of others: if it is not yours, leave it alone.**
- **Students are looked up to by those younger than them. Strive to be a good influence and role model. Your attitude and behavior are a reflection of the Lord Jesus, your church, and your family.**
- **Concerning the area of PDA (public displays of affection) while at student ministry events, there will be no girlfriend or boyfriend displays of affection. Please be part of the group and not just a couple.**
- **Wherever you are, while at church, school, home, sport events, parties, the mall, remember that you are a representative of Jesus Christ and First Baptist Church.**
